

NOTE TO VISITORS FOR PRIVATE TRANSPORT TO/FROM THE IRAM 30m OBSERVATORY

The access to the IRAM observatory in Sierra Nevada is established under strict safety rules (see information on the 30m web page on Safety). Rules are established by the direction and coordinated among the staff responsible for safety, the operator and the driver. Every week IRAM offers official guided transports between IRAM/Granada and the 30m observatory. Four transports go to the 30m, and six transports go back to Granada. IRAM strongly recommends that any visitor follows the official transports. In case you decide not to use the official transport and by your own decision you proceed to access or to leave the observatory following your own private ways, please complete this form and sign the requested information below sending it to IRAM by mail or email.

In all the cases is recommended that you phone contact the operator before you start your way up to the observatory and it is mandatory that you inform the operator before leaving the observatory.
